Steering Committee

-Reports and coordinates the important matters of each committee

Economic and Fiscal Policy Committee

- —Discusses and makes proposals (tax and finance) on medium- to long-term economic and fiscal management in a comprehensive manner to achieve both fiscal soundness and economic growth, and implements measures to realize these goals
- -Discusses economic and monetary policies while understanding the actual situation of the economic climate and trends

Corporate Legislation Committee

—Discusses, makes proposals relating to, and raises awareness of business systems (e.g., corporate governance, quarterly disclosure systems, accounting systems, competition policies) that contribute to corporate management from a medium- to long-term perspective, and conducts research on mechanisms for effectively harnessing the power of the private sector, based on the principle of shared benefit

Decentralization and Regional Administration Committee

—Performs surveys and makes proposals toward regional revitalization, decentralization, and the decentralized "Doshu-sei" regional government system, supports the development of the Union of Kansai Governments, and promotes wide-area cooperation in the Kansai region

Science Technology and Industrial Development Committee

—Comprehensively promotes industrial innovation toward the realization of Society 5.0, including cluster formation, science and technology, industrial policy, and human resource development in fields that lead to the promotion of next-generation growth industries such as aircraft, environment and energy, bioeconomy, as well as IoT, AI, and robotics, which are the Kansai region's strengths

Venture Ecosystem Committee

- —Promotes open innovation and cooperation between big companies and startups, and links startup support hubs throughout Kansai, such as Umekita and Keihanna
- -Supports efforts to generate innovation throughout the Kansai region

Global Environment and Energy Committee

Expresses opinions and takes specific actions regarding the policies necessary for the inexpensive and stable supply of energy, which is the foundation of consumer lifestyles and corporate activities, and for economic growth through GX and energy policies that are based on safety, energy security, economic efficiency, and the environment ("S+3E")

 Promotes digital transformation throughout Kansai (region and corporations), including building momentum as set forth in the Kansai DX Strategy 2025 and raising awareness among management

Sports Promotion Committee

Discusses sports promotion measures based on the Kansai Sports Promotion Vision, promotes concretization through
collaborations among industry, academia, and government, and works to build momentum and create a legacy for the World

Labor Policy Committee

—Discusses employment policies, labor policies, and labor laws in a comprehensive manner, supports organizing and solving the human resource and labor problems faced by small-and-medium-sized enterprises, and promotes efforts to become a "stage that attracts people" seeking opportunities to play an active role, as indicated in the Kansai Vision 2030
